

EXAMINATION RULES

- Unless specified by the invigilator/examiner, any electronic device and/or mobile technology/watches of any kind which are brought into the exam room must have all functions switched off. Medically prescribed devices are permitted.
- Leave bags, mobile phones, and other personal electronic devices at the front of the room.
- Items permitted on desks are:
 - ✓ Pens, pencils and similar stationery
 - ✓ Open Book exams only allowable reference materials as per Certification Standard
 - ✓ Water or similar
- Personal writing paper MUST NOT be used at any time.
- Candidates MUST NOT write on the back of the exam paper; extra paper is available if required.
- Use CBIP supplied paper for all workings; return this paper to the invigilator after the exam.
- Conversation and other non-verbal communication with other candidates is NOT allowed; candidates may communicate with the invigilator when necessary.
- Only one candidate at a time is permitted to leave the room.
- No exams will be marked, or results given on the day.
